POINTS of INTEREST

- Bring your completed Fairy House to the Front Gate during our first 3 Themed Weekends between 10am-5pm
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Prizes to be announced

- Patrons will vote on their favorite house and the judging will take place over our first three weekends.

CONSTRUCTION TIPS

- Create a strong base structure to build your house on for easier transport, although make it light enough to carry!
- The maximum footprint of said house needs to be 12" x 12" Unless the house is built as a tower, in which case the minimum height would need to be 24" with a base sturdy enough to hold it. Our Fae are fickle about how our houses plot. Some of us like the wide open ranch style, while others (Pixies mostly) like the condominium feel.
- Be creative! But please do not make them out of steel, iron, or hematite. These items have been known to have toxic effects on fairies.
- Our Fae like to be outdoors, and one simple rainstorm turns our paper houses into a pile of mush. Because of this items cannot be constructed out of paper products (i.e. cardboard, corrugate, paper boxes, etc) as their structure. Examples of acceptable materials can include: dry grasses, leaves, wood, sticks, bark, pebbles, pine cones, stones, acorns, feathers, seaweed, nuts, shells, and much more!
- Fairy houses should be fairly durable to weather elements in the Fairy Forest
- We recommend to use all natural materials to build your fairy house or garden
- Example of materials can include: dry grasses, leaves, sticks, bark, pebbles, pine cones, stones, acorns, feathers, seaweed, nuts, shells and much more!
- Decorate your house inside and out! This can include landscape and any indoor furnishings you wish to add.
- Our Secret Garden has plenty of limbs and gnarls from which to hang houses as well. Many Fae like their houses hanging from the trees. While others, brownies especially, like theirs sitting on the ground directly.
